André Núñez is an actor from Cuautitlán Izcalli, State of Mexico. His connection to the arts began in childhood, encouraged by his mother, who enrolled him in a variety of artistic and athletic activities. Although he explored disciplines such as painting, piano, and drums, it was acting that truly captured his attention at the age of 13. André is passionate about portraying characters inspired by those who have not had the opportunity to tell their own stories. "I dream of stories that challenge the way people think and transcend the screen."

He gained recognition for his performance in the short film *Nacimos Llorando* (2023), directed by Fernando Cattori. The film won Best Long Short Film in the LGBTQ+ category at the LA Film Festival and was nominated for the 1.4 Awards in the On the Cusp - Short Film Fiction category, as well as for Best Long Form Music Video at the 2024 Latin Grammy Awards. He recently completed filming *La Vida de Ahora*, a feature film that marks his debut in this format, directed by Alejandro Zuno, one of the most prominent emerging voices in Mexican auteur cinema. The project is currently in post-production.

André continues to develop his craft through workshops and film laboratories while maintaining ongoing acting training, primarily with acting coach María Fernanda Bosque. In parallel, he is pursuing a degree in Creative Writing and Literature at the University of the Cloister. Empathetic, cheerful, and curious, he finds inspiration in music, learning, and observing the world around him.
