Jorge Antonio Guerrero is an actor and director from Ecatepec, Estado de México. He's best known for his leading role in *Roma* (2018) by Alfonso Cuarón and for his portrayal of Cadete Tello in *Luis Miguel: The Series* (2017-2018). His performance in *Roma* earned him a nomination for Best Supporting Actor at the 2019 Ariel Awards, and he was also nominated for Best Breakthrough Actor at the 2022 Iris Quebec Awards. In 2022, he won the Best Performance award at the Centre Film Festival for his role in *We Are Living Things* (2019) and was recently recognized at the Independent Shorts Awards for *Ensayos*, his directorial debut.

Jorge's international credits include *Drunken Birds* (2019), directed by Ivan Grbovic, and *Without Blood* (2024), directed by Angelina Jolie. Growing up, he was passionate about sports—especially soccer—but it was his love for reading, inspired by his father, that ultimately led him to poetry and, eventually, acting.

He studied Literature at Universidad Autónoma Metropolitana, where he started reciting poetry in the subway, a moment that pushed him to explore acting. Martial arts have also played an important role in his artistic process, as he sees a deep connection between their philosophy, movement, and the stage.

Jorge is currently working on his first feature film. For him, art is a bridge that gives us a fresh perspective on reality and encourages us to question the images that shape it. "Dramatic art is essential for reinterpreting what we express. Our actions are a profound reflection of who we are."
