Luis Curiel was born in Mexico City and began his professional career at the age of eight. With experience across film, theater, and television, he has developed a versatile acting profile that moves between commercial productions, independent films, and streaming platforms. He trained at Sergio Jiménez's acting school and later joined the 2016 generation of the ANDA Actors Guild, further complementing his training with mentors and institutions such as ENAT and the CCC.

On stage, he has appeared in more than ten productions, including *Si Muero Lejos de Ti* at Foro Shakespeare, *Pez Globo* at Teatro de la Ciudad, Teatro Helénico and CCB, as well as the comedy *La Obra que Sale Mal*, which toured nationally. On television and streaming, he has worked on internationally distributed series such as *El Chapo* and *Control Z* on Netflix—earning a PRODU Awards nomination for Breakthrough Actor for the latter—along with *Un Extraño Enemigo* and *Cometierra* for Amazon Prime, *Te Quiero y Me Duele* and *Like Water* for Chocolate for HBO, and projects for Sony Pictures and Apple TV.

In film, he has appeared in feature productions such as *Olimpia*, directed by José Manuel Cravioto and winner of the 2020 Ariel Award, as well as internationally released films including *Fuga de Reinas* and *Contraataque* for Netflix. His work is marked by a constant search for emotionally and narratively complex characters, positioning him as a rising actor within the contemporary audiovisual landscape.

“I want to create, explore the limits of my emotions, and embrace the chaos; to lose myself and find myself again, live in spontaneity, and transform with every character—because acting is how I understand myself and connect with others.”
